Psychologist – Licensed SC Department of Juvenile Justice

(Multiple Positions throughout the State)

Under limited supervision, develops and implements community based psychological services (primarily evaluation and consultation) for youth involved with SC Department of Juvenile Justice. Services are provided within an assigned geographical area of the state. Provides evaluation services including clinical interviews with youth and family members, record reviews, consultations with DJJ County Office staff and other agencies involved with youth being evaluated. Provides administration and interpretation of psychological tests and measures; prepares reports and provides expert testimony in Family Court as required by attorneys or judges. Provides consultation to DJJ staff regarding youth involved with DJJ. Participates in DJJ treatment planning and management; consults in cases of youth with special needs (e.g. mental health or developmental issues); consults with DJJ County Office staff regarding problematic issues/cases. Performs other related duties as required, including select groups for juveniles/families.

A doctoral degree in applied psychology from an APA approved program in psychology and possession of a current license to practice psychology in the State of South Carolina or license eligibility within 12-18 months.
